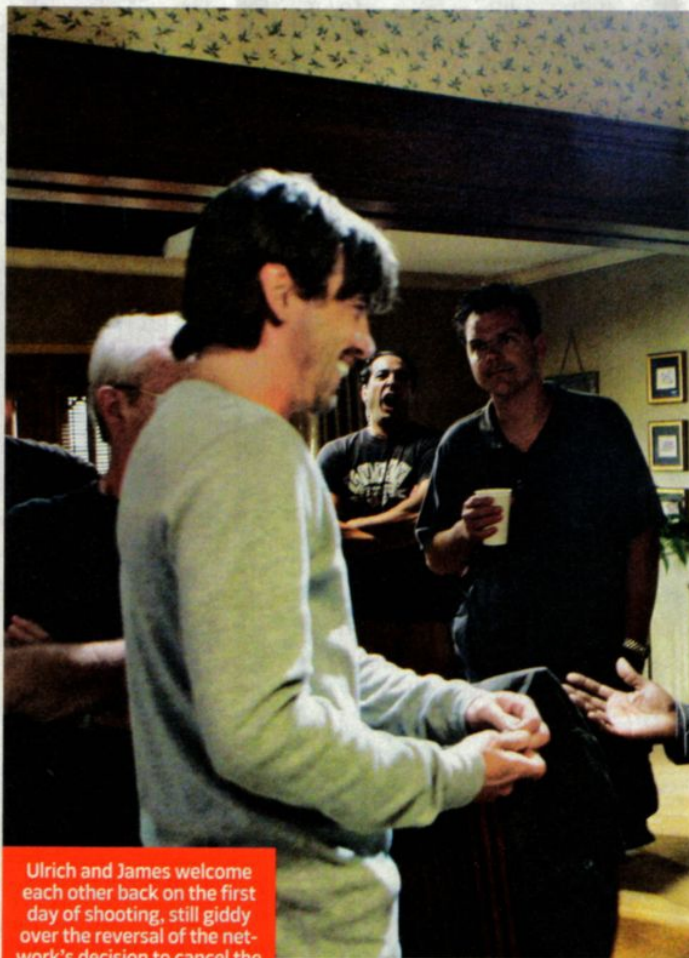

The story planned for a full second season has been packed into the seven episodes ordered by the network, and Barbee promises they won't disappoint those looking for answers about the nuclear attack.
